This agreement made in duplicate this 15 day of May, 1963, is in accordance with and supplements the provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding of September 15, 1959, between the Director, Michigan Department of Conservation and the Regional Forester, U. S. Forest Service, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, The Michigan Department of Conservation desires to protect the Kirtland's Warbler on its certain nesting grounds in Oscoda County, and;

WHEREAS, The Forest Service has dedicated an area of the Lower Michigan National Forest as a Management Area for the Kirtland's Warbler and is interested in the management and protection of this rare and perhaps vanishing species of bird.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the above promises:

The Lower Michigan National Forest Agrees:

1. To post signs permitting entrance to parts of the dedicated Kirtland's Warbler Management Area between May 1 and August 15 by written permit only.
2. To furnish permit blanks to the Department of Conservation, Mio Headquarters, which upon being
