Dear Mr. Deignan:

Our Washington Office has furnished us a copy of Mr. V. L. Harper's letter to you of December 26 in regard to the resolution of your organization recommending a Kirtland Warbler Preserve on the Huron National Forest. His letter suggested that this office may wish to elaborate on the plans that have been developed.

Our field people on the Lower Michigan National Forest have been working on plans for a Kirtland Warbler area. They will make an effort to protect and develop the special nesting requirements of this bird on this area. They have had excellent cooperation from Mr. Harold Mayfield and other qualified ornithologists in selecting this area and developing management plans for it.

This program is being carried out under recent multiple use planning procedures, which permit specific areas to be designated for one primary use. Although other uses, such as timber management are permitted, they must not conflict, and where possible, will be modified to harmonize with or even improve the benefits to the primary use.

We feel certain that the management plans which are being considered will meet the approval of your organization. If you have more specific questions, we will be pleased to hear from you. We appreciate the interest you have shown in the welfare of the Kirtland Warbler and the management of its habitat.

SUBJECT: Development and Control (Kirtland's Warbler Management Area)

We plan to complete the management plan for the proposed Kirtland's Warbler Management Area in the near future. It is our intent to enlist the cooperative support of a number of groups to assist us in the development of the area. The following groups have already indicated their support:

- The Detroit Audubon Society
- The Michigan Audubon Society
- The Michigan Natural Areas Council
- The Pontiac Audubon Society

The Management Plan is set up on a 5-year basis, with expenditures of cooperative funds estimated to be approximately \$1,500 per 5-year period. Copies of the Cooperative Agreement will be included with the Management Plan under the section on "Financing". We have added Clause 7 to the Agreement pending final approval of our Management Plan. The Cooperative Agreements will also serve to express the interest that these various groups have in this project.

It is our intent to complete the Agreement with at least 4 groups. Other groups have indicated a desire to support the project once it receives official approval. It may be that some groups would not be able to contribute \$100 per year. Therefore, we have stated "... , estimated to be in amounts of about \$100 per year."

We would appreciate your review and comments of the enclosed draft.
