SUBJECT: Plans - Kirtland's Warbler Interpretative Center

Under separate cover we are forwarding the site plan for the above area.

We have worked closely with this Office's I&E Section which is in the process of preparing the interpretative phase of the plan.

We normally would not establish a parking lot on the opposite side of the road from the attraction; however, in this case, it is felt that traffic will not create a dangerous hazard.

It is also not desirable to move the center further to the east. This would disrupt the pine thicket and interpretative phase of the plan. Moving the access road further to the west would encroach upon the intersection of Forest Roads 4452 and 4463.

Tables, toilets, and other facilities have not been included because of the nearness of Mack Lake Camp and Picnic Ground. If demand requires a toilet, one may be located near Station No. 1.

Upon your review and approval, we would appreciate receiving ten black-line prints of the plan.
